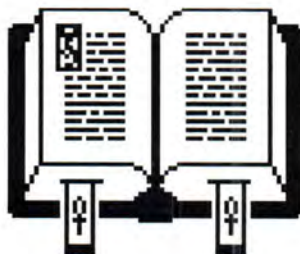

The Aris Woodham Senior Family Bible was the personal family Bible of Aris Woodham Senior and his wife, Rachel Beasley.

As shown by the title page date, the Bible was printed in the year 1815, three years prior to the death of Aris Senior.

Aris Sr. was a Methodist minister and may have used this Bible as a preacher.

The handwriting appears to have been done by at least three different people. The information on Aris Sr. and Rachel and their children is all in the same handwriting. The marriage of Stephen Woodham is in another person's handwriting. The death of Rachel in 1861 is in another handwriting. The death in 1834 (or 1854) may also be that of whoever recorded Stephsn's marriage or still a fourth person.

This indicates the "original" information may have been recorded by Aris Woodham Sr. himself, since Rachel could not read nor write.

As of August, 1988, the Aris Woodham Senior Family Bible is in the possession of Mrs. Gedelle Skinner Culpepper. Gedelle lives circa one mile north of Hebron Methodist Church in the Stokes Bridge Community of Lee County, South Carolina.

Gedelle lives next to her sister who has no children. Both sisters live alone.

In August, 1988, Woodham Family Historian visited Gedelle and made xerox copies of the family information and title page directly from the Bible with his own copying machine.

The first title page and first several pages of the Bible are missing.

However, the second title page, between the Old Testament and New Testament, is in good condition.

The original leather cover on the Bible is in very poor condition. An attempt was made to "repair" it with thick thread to hold it together. One of the pages containing family information has also been sewn back together with thick thread, apparently done many years ago.

Gedelle has only one heir, her daughter Hester Gail Culpepper (Now Mrs. Hester Gail Sapough (pronounced "Saypaw") ) of Norcross, Georgia, a suburb of Atlanta. Gedelle stated her daughter was not really interested in family history and did not actually have any interest in the Woodham Family Bible.

Robert Earl asked Gedelle to seriously consider donating the Bible to the Woodham Family National Library so that it would never be "lost" to the family again. Robert Earl told Gedelle it would be preserved for all future generations of our family to enjoy. He said the Woodham Family Association would in turn repair the Bible and restore it to good condition. She promised to talk to her daughter about it and that if Hester Gail did not want the Bible, Gedelle said she would then consider donating it to the Woodham Family.

Thank you for your letter concerning the Woodham Family Bible. For years I have been trying to convince people that Aris Woodham, Sr. was married to Rachael Beasley. I guess the time has come for a few people to agree with me.

I may be able to help you ~~of~~ out some with the dating of the Woodham Bible. I am enclosing a "dim" copy of the title page from the Bible. As you can see, it ~~at~~ gives the date 1815 as publication and "M. CAREY, No. 121 Chesnut Street, Philadelphia" as publisher.

You also asked for the original owner of the Bible. I don't know for sure, but believe the original owner to be Rachel Beasley Woodham and then her son Stephen Woodham.

Going back to the copy of the Bible record, when I made the xerox copy in 1973 or 1974 the machines available to make good photocopies could not be easily found in this area. Also making the task more difficult was the fact that the information was written in faded brown ink. (With a yellow tint). The photocopy machine did a poor job under these conditions.

I hope what I am sending will be of some help to you. If you need anything else, please advise me. You mentioned that I should write a statement concerning the Bible. I am ~~am~~ unsure what information you wish me to provide in the statement. Let me know about this.

I have heard of an Andrews - Woodham Bible but have not learned of its location or the information contained in such a Bible. If you have a copy, I would love to see it if I could.

I can't contribute any information on Margaret M. H. Smith's family. I will be pleased to do research on any Darlington - Sumter Co., S.C. families you may be interested in. I enjoy trading information with my genealogical friends.

Mrs. Dorothy Keith hinted at several of the problems she had experienced with her son and husband. I have not had much time to reply to her lately, but by summer I hope to be writing more people more often.

Dear Mr. Woodham,

Thank you for your letter concerning the **WOODHAM** family. It appears that you have been active in research and preservation in regard to the **WOODHAM** family.

The story of the discovery of the **WOODHAM** family Bible goes back to the early 1970's. When my grandmother, Mrs. Carnell Andrews, was alive, I spent much time asking about various members of the **ANDREWS** family. Her maiden name had been **ANDREWS**, before she married my grandfather, Harley E. Andrews. They lived in the Ashland section of Lee County, S.C., formerly Darlington County. She related a story about an uncle **STEPHEN WOODHAM** of hers. I was curious, and asked if she could find out more. Within a few weeks she said that we should go and visit Mrs. Gedell Culpepper. She was in possession of the **WOODHAM** Bible. Mrs. Culpepper was kind enough to loan it to me to have it copied. The variety of photocopy machines was very limited in Hartsville at that time. Also the information written in the Bible was in a brownish ink. The copy I was able to obtain was a very poor one, but the best available at that time. My grandmother died a few years after that, and Mrs. Culpepper moved away from this area. I believe she moved to the Columbia, S.C. area. The Bible was unavailable to copy with the improved copy machines. I was very reluctant to release my copy of the Bible to others. I finally enabled a genealogical friend to prove a DAR line with this Bible. It seemed from that point on, copies of the copy I sent her multiplied. Very few of the copies I have received second hand mentioned Mrs. Culpepper as the owner of the Bible. Several people wanted to tell me the new information they had discovered concerning an unknown **WOODHAM** Bible. Its almost like trying to trace down a rumor.

Soon after that, I made the first of two or three trips to the Dale Co.-Henry Co. area of Alabama. It didn't take long to find the Woodham Cemetery and various Woodham records in the Henry County courthouse. Besides the **WOODHAM** family, several other families from this area moved to the Southeastern section of Alabama, i.e. **ANDREWS, GALLOWAY, MIXON, MATHIS, COOLEY, WIGGINS, KNOTTS, REYNOLDS, WINDHAM, FIELDS, BIZZELL, NEWMAN**, etc. I was able to gather much information from the cemeteries and courthouses of the area.

The information about the cemetery is very interesting to me. I always wondered who was buried in the two graves that had the lattice work built around them.

I have seen the EDWARD WOODHAM records from N.C. concerning the Colonial Militia, the Granville and Dobbs County tax lists.

I have enclosed the family group sheet you sent me. The father of SAMUEL ANDREWS, THOMAS ANDREWS, moved to Dale County, Alabama along with several sons and daughters. One of the children of SAMUEL ANDREWS, PHARABA, lived in Dale County, before moving to Montgomery County, Texas. The last two children listed on the family group sheet were by the 2nd wife of SAMUEL ANDREWS, RUTHA THOMAS. You will notice the WOODHAM names in the family of SAMUEL and MARGARET ANDREWS, ARIS, STEPHEN, and PHARABA (FERABEY).

Please send me information concerning your newsletter. I have few good Xerox copies of materials. Most of the items I have concerning the WOODHAM family are hand copied.
