# The Army of the Confederate States

WOODHAMs who served as soldiers in Military Units of the States, including State Troops, County Militias and State Volunteers who served in the national army; and soldiers who served in the national Army of the Confederate States of America, during the War for Southern Independence (War Between the States).

### NOTE:

A man's name might be listed several different ways over a period of time due to many different rosters of men enrolled in a company.

Some men also may be shown in more than one military unit. At the beginning of the war, some organizations were enlisted for as short a period as three months and later six months. Later, some men enlisted for "the period of the war". As a result, when a man's enlistment period was up, he might then join another company. In many cases, entire companies were disbanded when their enlistment periods were over and most then re-enlisted, forming an entirely "new" company.

On several different company muster rolls, he is listed as "A.", "Amos" (or Aros) and Aris.

Aris died as a soldier in City Hospital, Vicksburg, Mississippi on I Nov., 1862.

He is buried at City Memorial Cemetery in Vicksburg; Grave # 328. (Potters Field)

ARIS

COMPANY I, 4th Alabama Reserve Infantry Regiment (Covington County, Alabama Militia)

Aris enlisted at Pollard, Escambia County, Alabama on August, 1863. Enlistment papers state he was born in S. C.; was age 40 and address: Goline, Ala.

Aris applied for a Confederate Veteran's pension on 17 Aug., 1901. His application states he was 82 years old and living at Poley, Covington County, Alabama.

Rachel Delaney Woodham, the widow of Aris, applied for and received a pension as the widow of a veteran.

#### ARIS ATHANASIUS

(Listed in military records as "A. A.")

COMPANY I 1st Alabama Regiment of Infantry

A. A. (Aris Athanasius) Woodham enlisted on 22 Feb., 1862 at Newton, Dale County, Alabama.

He was captured at the famous battles and seige of Island # 10 on the Mississippi River. He was among the Southern soldiers taken as a prisoner of war to the infamous Camp Butler, Springfield, Illinois (a yankee prisoner of war internment camp for Southern troops).

He was sent back to Vicksburg, Mississippi and was part of an exchange of prisoners made on 23 Sept., 1862. He went back on active duty.

A. A. was captured again by yankee troops at the Battle of Port Hudson, Louisiana. Port Hudson was the last Confederate stronghold on the Mississippi River and the Southerners fought hard to hold onto the town. The port city of Vicksburg, Mississippi had just fallen a few days before following a long horrible seige. A. A. was taken prisoner of war on 9 July, 1863.

He was paroled as a prisoner of war and exchanged on 12 July, 1863.

A newspaper obituary states A. A. Woodham was killed in action during the Battle of New Hope, in Paulding County, Georgia on 4 June, 1864. "...he was struck by a cannon ball just below his right shoulder and instantly killed. This battle was part of the Atlanta campaign when the yankee army under Sherman invaded Georgia; the Battle of New Hope was one of the many battles surrounding Atlanta, leading to the seige of the city.

The name A. A. Woodrum or Woodham has not been found on the rolls on file in this office of any Company of the 1st, Alabama Cavalry, nor has any record been found of his service, capture or parole as of that organization.

The records show, however, that one A. A. Woodham, Private, Company I. 1st Regiment Alabama Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted February 22, 1862, at Newton, for the period of 3 years. He was captured at Island number 10, April 8, 1862, and taken to Camp Butler, Springfield, Illinois. His name appears on a roll of prisoners of war sent from Camp Butler, Springfield, Illinois, to Vicksburg, Mississippi, September 23, 1862, to be exchanged.

He was again captured July 9, 1863, at Port Hudson, and was paroled

at Port Hudson, Louisiana, July 12 or 13, 1863.

Muster roll dated December 1863 shows him present. No later record has been found.

This company was at first designated as E. It was organized by Captain J. C. Simpkins, whom Governor Pickens had appointed to the captaincy of the 5th company of the proposed regiment, March 4, 1861. The muster roll of April 30, 1861, shows that at that time it was stationed at Sullivan's Island and had been so stationed previously thereto. The following additional muster rolls of the company are available: May 17, June 30, August 31, October 31, and December 31, 1861; April 30, June 30, August 31, October 31, and December 31, 1862; February 28, April 30, June 30, August 31, October 31, and December 31, 1863; February 29, June 30, August 31, October 31, and December 31, 1864.

(listed in military records as "A. J.", "A. Jehu")

COMPANY E 57th Alabama Regiment of Infantry Scott's Brigade, Loring's Division

Athanasius Jehu Woodham enlisted at Clopton, Dale County, Alabama, in Company E, 57th Alabama Regiment of Infantry.

This military unit took part in the defense of Atlanta, Georgia against the invading yankees. During one of the many Battles of Atlanta, A. J. was wounded on 20 July, 1864, near Atlanta. He was furloughed for 30 days to recover from his wounds. He was shot in the left hand.

A. J. Woodham Sr. applied for a Confederate Veteran's pension on 1 Mar., 1898. At the time of his application, he was engaged in farming and lived at White Pond, Henry County. He stated he owned two acres of land.

#### JOHN WESLEY

(Listed as "J. W." in military records)

COMPANY A 7th Battalion, South Carolina Infantry

John Wesley Woodham was born in 1835 in Darlington County, South Carolina (in that area which later became Lee County).

John Wesley enlisted on 14 Nov., 1861 at Lynches Creek (now called the Stokes Bridge Community of Lee County), S.C. He was listed as age 25.

COMPANY F 7th Battalion,

It is not known whether Company A later became Company F or whether John Wesley transferred from one company to another. However, he is also listed on the muster roll of Company F.

At the end of the war, when Confederate troops were surrendered to the yankee army in North Carolina, John Wesley was among those paroled by the yankees at Greensboro, North Carolina on 1 May, 1865.

#### JOHN WESLEY WOODHAM

(Listed as John Woodham in military records)

COMPANY G, 15th Alabama Regiment of Infantry "Henry Pioneers"

John Wesley Woodham enlisted on 15 Aug., 1864 in Company G, 15th Alabama Regiment of Infantry (known as the "Henry Pioneers") as a "Recruit for E.C. Woodham".

During the war, both the Confederate and yankee armies allowed men to hire or otherwise obtain a substitute for themselves so they would not have to serve active military duty. Edward Christopher Woodham got his son, John Wesley Woodham, to enlist as a substitute for himself.

John enlisted in Dale County, Alabama. The company muster roll states he was born in Alabama, was a farmer, his post office address was Goline, Alabama. His age was first written as 16 but this was marked over with the age 17.

The statement "Recruit for E. C. Woodham" was also later marked through.

# JOSEPH JOHN WOODHAM

(Listed as John J. Woodham in military records)

COMPANY D, 57th Alabama Regiment of Infantry

Joseph John Woodham enlisted in Company D, 57th Alabama Regiment of Infantry. He enlisted as "John J."

Joseph John was a resident of Henry County, Alabama. He was the son of Reddick Woodham.

Joseph J. is also listed in Company E of this same regiment, 57th Alabama Regiment of Infantry.

### JOSEPH REDDICK

(Listed as in military records)

COMPANY G 15th Alabama Reginent of Infantry

Joseph Reddick Woodham was a resident of Dale County, Alabama.

The date and place of enlistment of Joseph R. is not known.

Joseph R. deserted the Southern Army in 1864; this was probably at the same time that his cousin, James R. Woodham, deserted in East Tennessee (11 Feb., 1864).

Joseph R. was shipped to Florida by the yankees and he then joined the notorious 1st Florida Cavalry, composed of Southern deserters, renegades and negro slaves. This outfit raided northwest Florida and Southeast Alabama, burning and pillaging homes throughout the area which was undefended because all the men were away in the army at the time.

COMPANY E 57th Alabama Regiment of Infantry

Joseph J. Woodham enlisted in Company E, 57th Alabama Regiment of Infantry at Selma, Ala. in 1862, according to his widow's Alabama pension records, and his enlistment records.

The enlistment records state he was born in 1844 in Henry County, Alabama.

Joseph J. was living in Henry County, Alabama when he enlisted in the army.

COMPANY D 57th Alabama Regiment of Infantry

It is not known whether Joseph J. enlisted in two different companies or whether Company Dlater became part of Company E.

Joseph J. enlisted in Company E, 57th Alabama Regiment of Infantry on 17 Feb., 1863 in Dale County, Alabama.

Mrs. Nora A. Woodham, widow of Joseph J., applied for and received a Widow's pension from the State of Alabama on 12 Feb., 1912. She lived in Henry County, Ala. at the time.

#### LEWIS H.

(Listed as "L. H." in military records)

COMPANY E 2nd Louisiana Cavalry Regiment

Lewis H. Woodham was born in Blount County, Alabama, son of Everett B. Woodham. He moved to DeSoto Parish, Louisiana at a young age.

L. H. Woodham enlisted on 15 July, 186- in Company E, 2nd Louisiana Cavalry at Bethel, Natchitoches Parish, Louisiana. He was given the rank of Sergeant of the Company.

His date of enlistment (or promotion to the rank of Sergeant) may also be 21 Aug., 186- at Camp Butler, Louisiana.

Lewis H. served in the Army throughout the war. He was captured by the yankees at Thibodaux on 27 Oct., 1862 but later swapped during a prisoner of war exchange and returned to active duty.

At the end of the war, they yankees gave him a parole at Shreveport, Louisiana on 21 June, 1865.

Richard E. L. Woodham enlisted in Company D, 57th Regiment of Alabama Infantry, Confederate States Army.

An article which appeared in THE SOUTHERN STAR newspaper of Ozark, Alabama on 3 Oct., 1928 and written by T. Alph Windham, stated Windham had the muster roll of his father, the commanding officer of the company, and listed the men and officers named on the muster roll. R. E. L. Woodham was listed among "Miscelleanous Officers".

#### ROBERT AURELIUS

(Listed as "R. A." and "Robert A." in military records)

COMPANY I 64th Georgia Regiment of Infantry, Army of Northern Virginia

Robert Aurelius Woodham was born in Greene County, Georgia and lived his entire adult life in Stewart County, Georgia.

Robert A. enlisted in Company I, 64th Georgia Regiment of Infantry at Columbus, Muscogee County, Georgia.

His residence was listed as Stewart County, Georgia.

The Company muster roll of 31 Aug., 1863 states he was home on sick leave since 19 July, 1863. His furlough was extended at the General Hospital, Columbus, Ga. He died while at home on sick leave with the measles which were contracted while in the Army. He died 1864 at home.

#### ROBERT NELSON

(Listed as "R. M", "R. N.", "R. Nelson" and Nelson in military records)

COMPANY H 3rd Alabama Regiment of Infantry

Robert Nelson Woodham enlisted in Company H, 3rd Alabama Regiment of Infantry,

Robert N. moved with his father, Aris Woodham, from Dale County, Alabama to Covington County, Alabama sometime during the war. Company H of the 3rd Alabama Regiment was composed mostly of men from Covington County.

At the end of the war, among the names of the men listed with the Southern Army which was surrendered to the yankees at Appomattox Court House, Virginia in April, 1865,

Nelson Woodham was listed in Company H, 3rd Alabama Regiment of Infantry; "Detached to Division Provost Guard." This indicates he may have been detailed to guard prisoners at the time.

COMPANY G 15th Alabama Regiment of Infantry R. Nelson is also listed as a private in Company G, 15th Alabama Regiment of Infantry. This company was composed of men from Dale and Henry Counties. Robert Nelson's father, Aris Woodham, moved from Dale County to Covington County sometime during the war; so Robert Nelson may have served from both counties.
