On your laundry mark...get set...

There's a ratings race going on among the local women's talk shows.

A year ago they all had their territories firmly staked out with no intrusions on one another. Zaria Zed as on at 9 a.m., right after the today show; Pat Woodham was in the 10:30 a.m. slot; and Kathryn Willis had the 1 p.m. time period all herself. But gradually in the past few months all that has changed. And for the last three months the three local women's talk shows have been going head-to-head at 9 a.m.

So now there's a war going on. To be sure, it's a friendly war. But nonetheless, a fierce battle for the ratings.

Who's ahead?

Sources at both channel 11 and channel 5 confirm that in the one ratings book that's come out since Kathryn Willis' shift back in February, Ms. Willis is ahead.

And things are happening at channel 5, although at this writing nothing has been announced. Our source says WCYB is considering expanding the Open House show to an hour and going to a more Today-type format, maybe even with a man as co-host.

To include channel 19 and the "Somebody Special" show in a discussion of a ratings war is really unfair. WKPT is at a big disadvantage in any ratings comparison because its signal is in the upper range of the dial and doesn't get out as far as channel 5 and channel 11.

competition by three programs for the same audience.

Each of the three hostesses talked with us about her program and how she sees it.

Pat Woodham has very fond memories of her three years as a women's talk show host.

"You know I really couldn't pick out one guest who's 'most memorable.' They've all been very special.

"I guess one of the most interesting was Dr. Wen Yen Tsao. He was one of the first people who escaped from Red China and he had some really remarkable stories to tell.

"And, of course, there have been many memorable celebrity-type guests — Governor Dunn, Governor Blanton, Mercedes McCambridge, George Plimpton.

A glimpse in Pat's scrapbook turns up the names of Jim McKay of ABC Sports, Sesame Street's Bob McGrath, Broadway actress Ann Buckles, Senator Lloyd Bentsen, Archie Campbell, Helene Curtis, and "anybody who's ever run for office."

Pat says getting the Somebody Special Show job was a fluke.

"I had done TV before. When we lived in Birmingham I used to do a weekly 90-minute fashion show. But

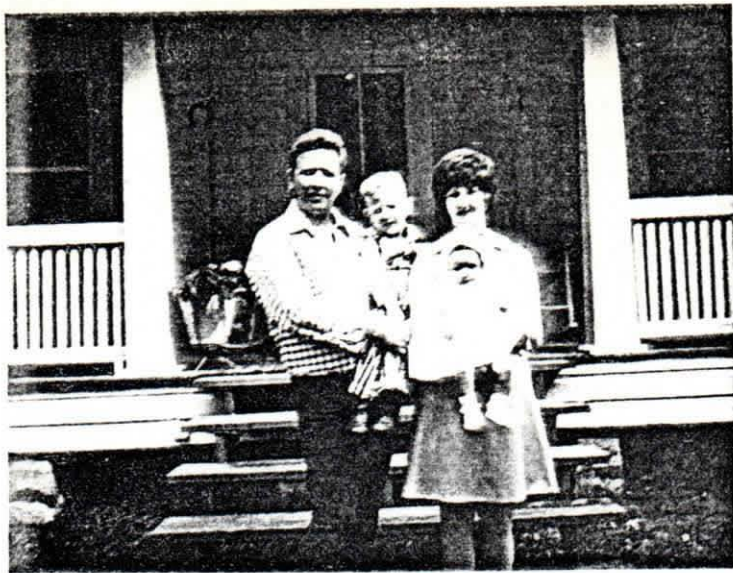

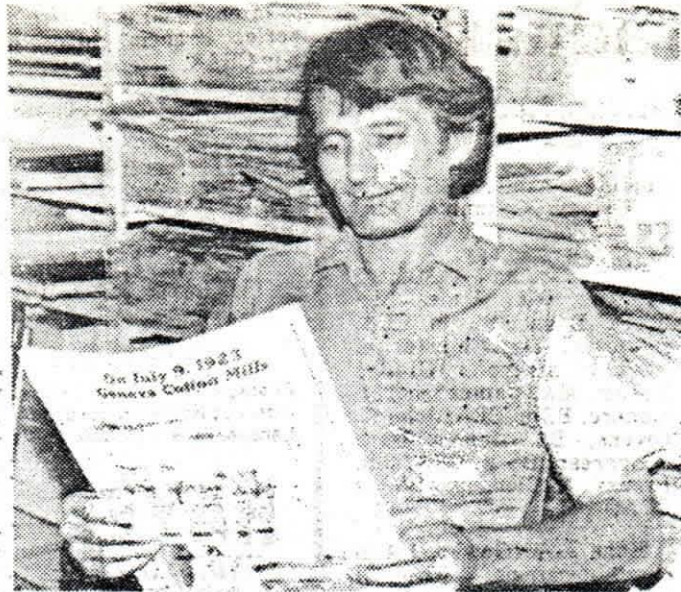

RESEARCHER — Robert E. Woodham, Atlanta, is researching the genealogy of the Woodham family. He recently said all Woodhams descended from a single man who came to this country in 1654.

Atlantan Writing Woodham History

GENEVA— Robert E. Woodham of Atlanta was in Geneva recently searching for information about the Woodham family. He is writing a history of the Woodhams, and says that all Woodhams — whether or not they spell it that way — are descended from one man who came to this country in 1654.

He says that whether a Woodham spells it "ham, um, hem" or however, they are all related. And the same thing is true, he says of Odum, Odem, Odam, Odom or even Oldham — all of them are related too. And the same thing holds true with Infingers and Enfingers.

The author explained that the difference in spelling came about in the early years in the South, when the educational system was almost nonexistent. "People who could read and write were the county officials. They spelled the names the way people said them, and that led to the change in spelling."

This rule does not hold true, Woodham said, for Smiths and Jones. . . "All of them are not related, because so many people changed their names to these more common ones."

Woodham claims kin to Geneva County's former sheriff, Cuthbert Woodham who was killed in 1957. He was a cousin. He also claims the late M. M. Woodham and his family and says he has scrapbooks full of Woodham history and accomplishments — such as those of Jean Woodham, former Geneva resident, and now a well-known New York sculptor.

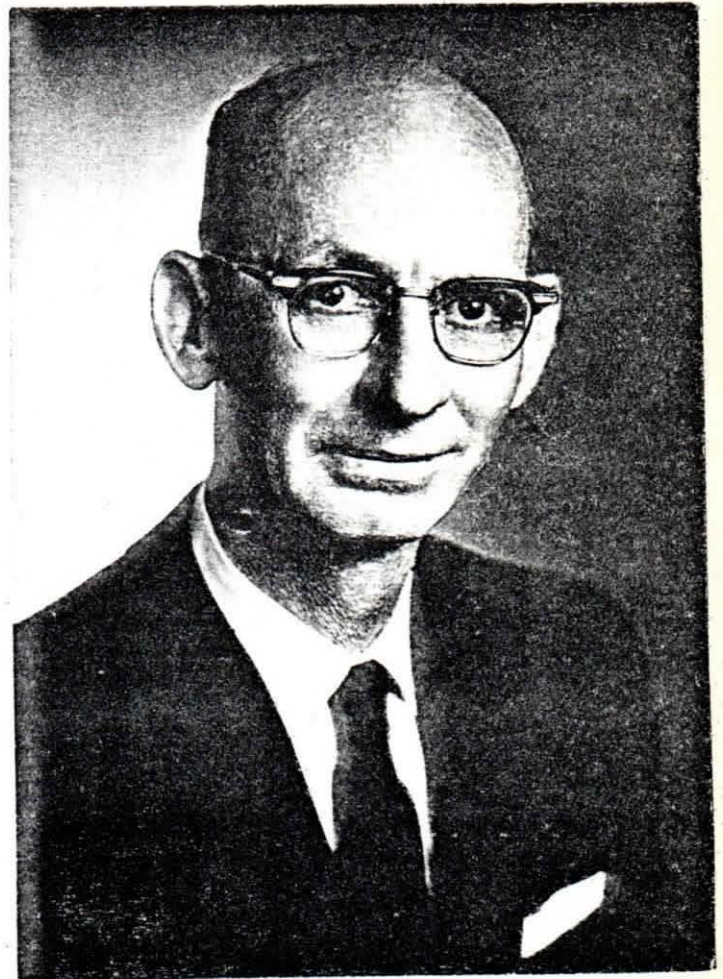
A former newspaper editor, Woodham has worked for the Atlanta Constitution, and until recently for the Independent Sentinel, Georgia's largest weekly newspaper. There he was the assistant editor.

Woodham has spent, he said, "hundreds of hours" researching the Woodham family and he also has done research on Sassers, Conyers, Odums and Enfingers, or Infingers.

He is also writing a reference book on population shifts in the South. This is in an effort to fill in some gaps in this subject so that historians and scholars may have more information. Woodham said that professors at Emory University are advising him on the areas which need researching.

Following the afternoon program, the hostesses assisted by Mrs. Cochran, served refreshments. A relaxed informal time was enjoyed by all.

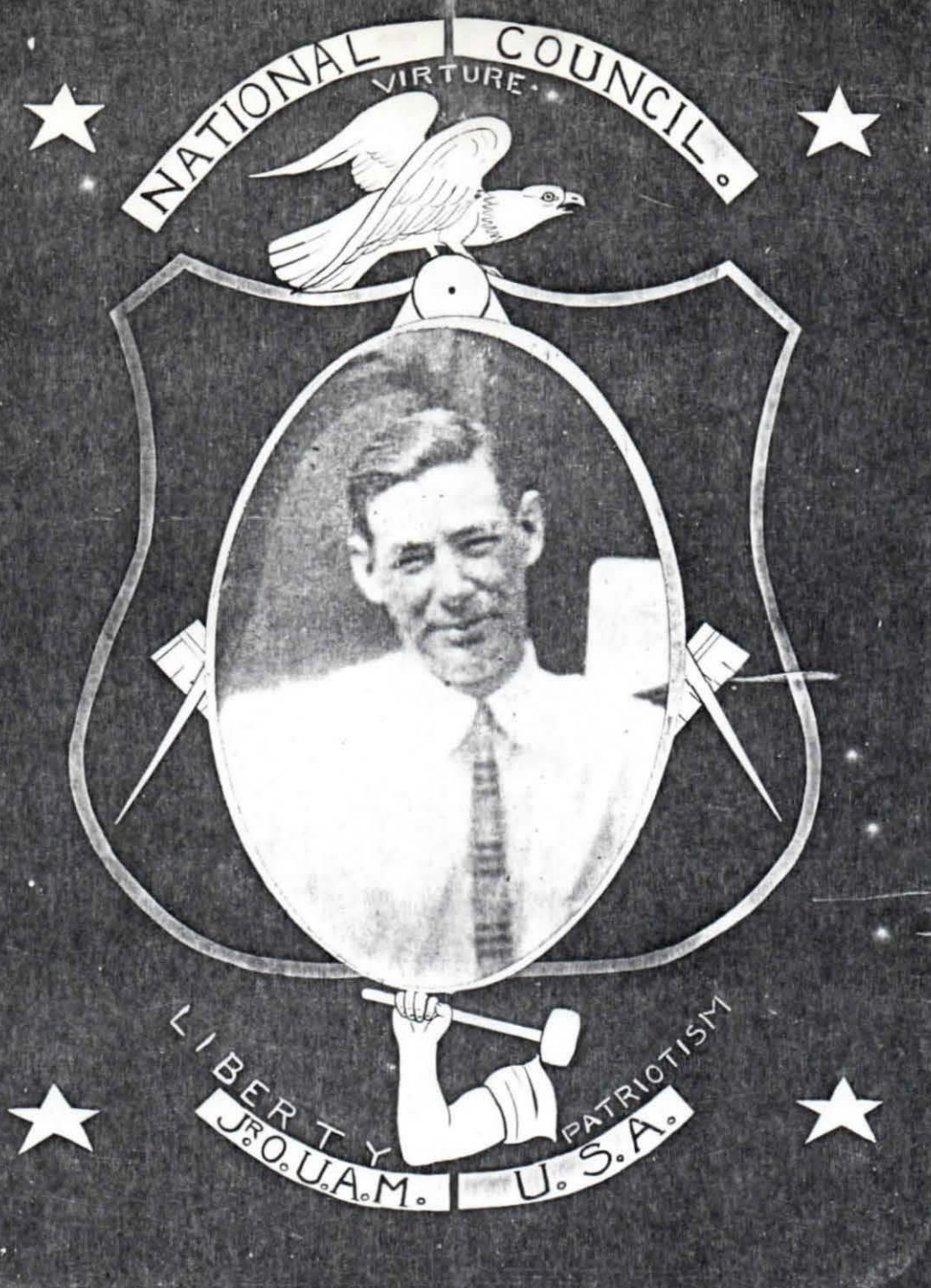
